- 3. The specific direction(s) to be pursued;
- 4. The direct and immediate relevance of the work proposed to Huntington disease (i.e., improved understanding of pathogenic mechanisms; significance with respect to the development of new treatments);
- 5. The scientific excellence of the research proposal; the potential relevance of the work proposed to other neurodegenerative disorders;
- 6. The specific rationale for support, including financial reasons (i.e., how will support enable the laboratory to pursue research not funded from other sources, and also contribute to the emergence of special areas of knowledge and expertise within the international framework for HD research);
- 7. The laboratory's established research interests, areas of special expertise, and resources.
